...I become all things to all men, so I might by all means save some" -1Cor. 9:20-22

For any kingdom task to be accomplished:

- ✓ **Faith sets the pace** *Hab.2:1-4/Jhn 6:26-28*
- ✓ Passion stirs the required moves Rom. 8:35-39/1 Cor. 9:16-17
- ✓ Faith delivers the task Heb. 11:32-34/ Mak. 9:23

We have the following scriptural illustrations that validates this truth:

First, the woman with the issue of blood said, if she could just touch the helm of Jesus' garment, she would be made whole; faith set the pace, passion drove her weak body through the crowd and faith delivered her healing — Luk. 8:40-48

Secondly, the blind Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was passing by, he believed if he could get His attention, he would receive his sight; he was driven by unstoppable passion and faith got his sight restored — *Mak.* 10:46-52

Thirdly, the paralytic man believed that with Christ in town, he must be healed; passion got him to take the roof option for access and faith got him out of his sick bed — Mak. 2:1-12

Above are all illustrations of a by all means approach to getting at one's target.

Among others, this implies that whatever we do not believe, passion can never deliver, because passion is barren without faith — Heb. 11:1/6

We have these episodes in this Commission in recent times that further establishes this claim:

- ➤ The mandate to plant 5,000 new Churches within one year and 10,000 the year that followed were very tall orders, but faith received them, passion got us on the move and faith got the seemingly impossible task done in grand styles as we saw 5,082 and 10,400 Churches planted in 2019 and 2020 respectively in spite of the Covid-19 trauma all to the glory of God.
- ➤ Secondly, we got another divine directive of entry into 75 new nations in one year.

Again, faith set the pace, passion stirred the move and faith delivered the task, as God opened the door to 85 new nations in the year 2022. Again, to God be all the glory!

Therefore, it is no big deal for any believing and kingdom advancement-passionate Winner to see minimum four souls saved and established within the next four weeks, if such individual will actively engage the vital forces of faith and passion as narrated here — Mak. 9:23/1 Cor. 9:20-22

This implies that a 'by all means' passionate approach with the demands of this season will deliver the set goal of any one of us like a dream of the night — Psa. 126:1-3

Remember, the kingdom of God suffers violence and only the violent can take it by the force of faith, but faith without required actions is dead — Jam. 2:24/26

- ✓ For example, Abraham believed God and he moved — Gen. 12:1-3/4
- ✓ Moses believed the prophetic word and headed back to Egypt — Exo. 3:7-10/ Exo. 4:17-20
- ✓ Peter believed Christ and left all to follow Him — Luk. 5:1-11
- ✓ Paul believed God, immediately he arose and conferred not with flesh and blood
 — Gal 1:15-16
