ONE CANNOT BE TRULY DEDICATED TO GOD AND NOT EMERGE A WONDER AT THE END

What is Dedication?

In our context, dedication implies:

- Serving God without reservation — Mat. 22:37/ Mak. 12:30
- Making one's life a seed unto God after the order of Christ — Jhn. 12:24-26.

From scriptures, we understand that every child of God is a seed after the order of Christ — Jhn. 12:23-26/Gal. 3:29

But one's life must become a seed indeed in the kingdom earth, in order to fully realize his/ her glorious destiny in Christ — Phil.1:21/ Col. 3:3

However, dedication is neither a gift nor a calling, but rather a choice — Jhn 10:17-18

When one chooses to serve God as a seed, he continues to flourish like a palm tree, that is, without experiencing a dry season in the adventure of life — *Psa.* 92:12-14

When one chooses to serve God as a seed, he has secured his glorious destiny in grand styles — Josh. 24:15/ Mak. 10:28-30

Serving God as a seed supernaturally enthrones the believer — *Phil.2:5-11/Heb. 12:1* Everyone that chooses to serve God as a seed is ordained to impart on his generations after him after the order of David — *Psa. 22:30/ Mat. 1:1/Rev. 3:7* As we all know, one cannot be honoured by God and be molested by men.

- ✓ One cannot be honoured by God and be assaulted by devils
- ✓ To be honoured by God connotes enthronement, among others.

But obedience is what defines servanthood, and no one can know the worth of obedience to instructions of scriptures until he has obeyed — Deut. 28:1

Obedience may be costly, but the end result is priceless — 1 Sam.15:22/ Phil. 2:5-9

When one goes after God as a 'dummy', he is on the covenant highway to commanding dominion. God once said to me, "there is a place to you on top, if you are interested" and I answered, "I am interested' then He responded, 'whatever I tell you to do, do it' — Deut. 28:1

However, every seed must first subscribe to the heat underneath the earth before it's full potentials can be made manifest. This is illustrated in the parable of mustard-seed, though it be tiniest of all seeds, "but when it is sown, it grows up, and shoots out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow, that is, providing succor for many". Dedication can turn any believer to a phenomenon among men -Mak. 4:30-32/1 Cor. 2:9

The following examples validate the power of dedication to God: Abraham, Moses, David, Peter, and Paul — *Isa. 5:1-3/ Heb. 6:12*

Receive grace to be listed among the dedicated ones in these last days, in the name of Jesus Christ!
